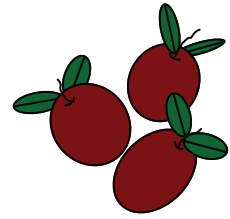
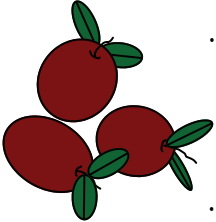


Cranberry Gathering

- Registration will be in Bouck Hall which is highlighted on our On-line map of the campus. Our good friends, Betsy and Kate, will once again be on duty starting at 1:00 to check you in, hand out your packets and answer your questions.
- When you register at the Gathering, you'll receive a map of the campus. Use this to locate the buildings housing workshops, concerts, vendors, meals, etc.
- Once you've found your building, look for Big Red Cranberries with the room numbers on them.
- Remember our new **Need a Buddy · Be a Buddy** program. If you're a rookie and would like a Buddy to guide you through the Gathering, or if you're a veteran and would like to help out by being a Buddy, be sure to indicate that on your registration form. - If you must bring a pet with you, remember that all pets must be "invisible" to all but their owners, and kept in campers or rooms except for necessary, unobtrusive leash time.
- There will be no alcohol allowed in any public areas on campus. Get high on the music!
- Please refrain from any audio or video taping of concerts or open stage without the express permission of the performer and the Gathering.
- There will be transportation available for anyone who has difficulty walking from one place to another.
- There will definitely be bathroom facilities available to campers overnight
- On-campus sleeping is in single beds, not bunks, and there is no charge for linens - just need to reserve 'em.
- There will be a limited number of mountain dulcimers and autoharps available for loan to those who might want to try a workshop, but don't have an instrument.
